**ENTRIES:** All athletes and coaches must enter via AdminSkiRacing registration site.

Alaska Division is utilizing an online registration site for collection of race fees for race administration for all events. This site adds a 6% processing fee in addition to the race entry fee. (YSL Race Series = \$20, Admin fee of

\$1.20) to be charge at time of registration

**ENTRY FEES:** \$20 for the entire race series regardless of number of races being

participated in. (No discounts for individual races).

**ENTRIES DEADLINE:** Registration will remain open through March 3, 2024. Initial race seeding

will be finalized by 6pm the evening before the scheduled race date.

\*Any late race entries day of race will be determined by Host Site. All participants will be seeded by class and gender and late participants will

be seeded at end of class.
