- Club Round Table – UPDATES
 - AVST – Not much to report. Arctic Valley IS scheduled to be open on Saturday for opening day. Have been training at Hilltop waiting to get open.
 - ASC – Has some FIS crew in Snow King, Wy currently. Thanks to Boda and Hilltop for hosting a good race. Coca-Cola is looking good on race trail. Proposal to Coaches working group to change up U16/18 State Champs calculations and will then propose to ACC.
 - HART – Trying to get in some laps on GS skis. Happy the Ram's Cup went off so well. Had a couple of athletes step away and when they saw the Ram's Cup, they are back to training, so hoping we can keep that momentum going.
 - JSC – Record Cold, record snow, 7" of rain, hurricane winds predicted. Not sure where to start! General Manager resigned on Thursday and Board of Directors resigned on Thursday. Ptarmigan Chair Lift has not been opened. Still going through inspections to reopen. Lodge has been without running water for 3 weeks now. Porta Potties in the parking lot. Tough to be optimistic about state champs right now. Winch Cat is in the shop and mechanics don't know when they can get it repaired. There is only 1 working Cat right now. Lost the Black Bear Chairlift with no plans to fix it. Erin Lupro is the acting General Manager (she is also the head of ski school, pro shop, etc.) Bringing a crew up for Coca-Cola! Would like a

 - FSC – Came down on Wednesday last week to train Wed – Friday and then raced the Ram's Cup. So surprised and happy to see the improvements at Hilltop. Not coming down again until Alyeska Cup.
 - UAA – No report.
- Official's Report; Conor Lynch
 - Continuing Education is now annual, not bi-annual. There are some opportunities via zoom to do some other updates so everyone can get up to date. If they do it this week, and Conor has an attendance sheet, it will be considered current for Coca-Cola. PNW and Lucy are doing more updates and Lucy will do an additional if needed for AK but would like as many to jump in on the already scheduled options first before trying to schedule that.
 - Change from bi-annual to annual was made to make it easier to track when people are up to date.
 - Concern is that it is tough to get people outside of those who work outside of ski racing to put in more effort to be an official if there are so many layers to be able to be involved.
 - Maybe a survey at the end of the season to see the pluses and minuses to this and if Divisions are struggling to get people and keep people up to date readily. And how this rule change affected volunteer officials.
